## Terminology

*Some key words and concepts covered in this programme of work:*

Refugee	A person who escapes to another country to seek safety from war or natural disaster or bad treatment
Migrant	A person who moves across an international border to another country to find better life
Immigrant	A person who comes to live permanently in another country
Border	A line separating two countries
Asylum	Protection given by a country to a person who has left their home country as a refugee
Safe	Being protected from potential harm or danger
Compassion	To be able to sympathise and feel concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others
Empathy	To be able to understand and share the feelings of another person

### *Supplementary words to further develop learning*

Persecution	Treating people badly because of their culture, beliefs, where they come from, or their political beliefs
Civil War	A war between groups of people within the same country
Human Rights	A right which is believed to belong to every person
Natural Disasters	Natural events that cause great damage, such as a hurricane, flood, famine or earthquake
