Refugee Camp	A camp set up for the accommodation of refugees
Migrant	A person who moves across an international border to another country to find better life
Immigrant	A person who comes to live permanently in another country
Border	A line separating two countries
Asylum	Protection given by a country to a person who has left their home country as a refugee
Rejection	To be dismissed or refused to be part of something
Belonging	To feel safe and included, as if you are meant to be there.
Compassion	To be able to sympathise and feel concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others
Empathy	To be able to understand and share the feelings of another person
Commonality	Things that are the same, that you share with others, that you have in common

Persecution	Treating people badly because of their culture, beliefs, where the come from, or their political beliefs
Civil War	A war between groups of people within the same country
Human Rights	A right which is believed to belong to every person
